RUSSELL FIRE-RESCUE STATION

January 20, 2016

Chairman Madden called the meeting to order at 5:30 pm. Trustee Gabram and Mueller were present. Fiscal Officer Charles Walder was also present.

MINUTES: *Mr. Mueller made the motion to accept the minutes of the Regular Meeting held on January 6, 2016, as presented. Mr. Gabram seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.*

QUARTERLY REPORTS: *Mr. Gabram made the motion to accept the* 4th *Quarter* 2015 departmental reports from the Fire, Police, Road, and Zoning departments. *Mr. Mueller seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.*

IMPROVEMENT OF WATT ROAD: RESOLUTION: Mr. Walder explained that resolution 2016-1 was a resolution to allow the County Engineer to create formal specifications and obtain eight votes for the paving of Watt Road. A unanimous vote of all Trustees is required to move forward with the project.

Mr. Mueller made the motion to approve Resolution 2016-1, a Resolution of Convenience and Necessity for the improvements of Watt Road (TR158), which authorizes the Geauga County Engineer to prepare engineering plans for the improvements of Watt Road in Russell Township. Mr. Gabram seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

BOARD OF ELECTIONS: Mr. Walder asked to be the signatory and contact on the contract for the Board of Election to allow them to use the Town Hall as a polling location on March 15 for the primary election.

Mr. Mueller made the motion to authorize Fiscal Officer Charles Walder to sign the agreement for the Election Day Polling Location. Mr. Gabram seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

UAN 2016 AGREEMENT: Mr. Walder advised the Trustees that the Auditor of State has changed the UAN contract so that it has to be renewed annually and have all three Trustees signatures on file. There are no other changes in the contract or the pricing of the Uniform Accounting Network that is provided through the Auditor of State.

Mr. Mueller made the motion to authorize Fiscal Officer Charles Walder to execute the Auditor of State's Uniform Accounting Network agreement for calendar year 2016. Mr. Gabram seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC WERE RECEIVED

LAND USE GUIDE PLAN: The Russell Township Zoning Commission has not finished the update on the Land Use Guide Plan so the Trustees need to extend the effective date of the current Land Use Guide Plan for the 2016 year.

Mr. Gabram made the motion to approve Resolution 2016-2 extending the effective date of the comprehensive Land Use Guide Plan. Mr. Mueller seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

ETHICS TRAINING DESIGNEE: *Mr. Gabram made the motion to approve Jennifer Dorka , a public employee, as the designee appointed to receive ethics training on behalf of elected officials Jim Mueller and Justin Madden of Russell Township. Mr. Mueller seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.*

REQUEST FOR USE OF TOWN HALL: *Mr. Mueller made the motion to grant permission for the Geauga County Board of Elections to use the Town Hall on March 15, 2016 from 5:30 am - 9 pm, subject to Township rules and regulations. Mr. Gabram seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.*

REQUEST FOR USE OF TOWN HALL: *Mr. Gabram made the motion to grant permission for the Hemlock Hills HOA to use the Town Hall on the 3rd Sunday of each month in 2016 from 6:30 pm - 10 pm, subject to Township rules and regulations. Mr. Mueller seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.*

EXECUTIVE SESSION: *Mr. Gabram made the motion to move into executive session to consider the compensation of public employees, pursuant to ORC 121.11 (G)(1). Mr. Mueller seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.*
