POLICY MANUAL: Mr. Dickinson reported that he had a few suggestions for the Personnel Policy Manual before it is approved, including preferred hiring for veterans.

COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC WERE RECEIVED AND ACCEPTED.

HERITAGE HOME PROGRAM: The trustees discussed the benefits of the Heritage Home Program to the residents, including free advice on their 50 year-old or older homes and low-interest rate loans to fix up or repair the homes. Several residents have offered positive feedback on interest in the program. Mr. Madden made the motion to authorize Russell Township's participation in the Heritage Home Program for residences that are 50 years old or older. Mr. Mueller seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

APPOINTMENT-BOARD OF ZONING APPEALS: Mr. Mueller made the motion that Sarah Moore be appointed to a full 5-year term on the Board of Zoning Appeals commencing January 1, 2014. Mr. Madden seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

2014 MEETING SCHEDULE CHANGE: The second trustees' meeting in December is cancelled; the following meeting after the December 4th meeting will be on January 8th, 2014.
