The Geauga County Board of Developmental Disabilities (GCBDD), known as The Bessie Benner Metzenbaum Center, was started in 1966 to help individuals in Geauga County with developmental disabilities. Our focus today is still on enhancing the lives of those we serve. These services begin at birth and continue with preschool and school programs, lasting through adulthood.

Employment First

 This program worked with 464 total individuals, of which 117 individuals are employed in minimum wage or above.

Early Intervention

- Early Intervention (EI) is a statewide system that provides coordinated early intervention services to parents of eligible children ages 0 - 3 years with developmental delays or disabilities.
- This program currently serves 110 120 children every year with disabilities and delays.

Transportation

- GCBDD coordinates transportation services with companies so that individuals are able to participate in day programs and work in the community.
- GCBDD is currently working with seven companies to transport individuals to community jobs.

Community and Residential Services

- Approximately 700 individuals and families receive support through Service and Support Administrators or El case managers.
- We currently have over 209 individuals receiving residential supports in our community in a variety of settings.
- We work with over 125 companies to meet the needs of individuals with developmental disabilities in terms of case management and community or residential services.

Recreation

 Individuals are able to enjoy many different activities throughout the year, such as Special Olympics, social and exercise options.

Intermediate Care Facilities

 The Intermediate Care Facility (ICF) currently provides residential care at the Metzenbaum Center for 21 individuals ranging in ages from 25-73.
