Dear Ms. Palmer:

I am writing to ask permission of the Board of Trustees to utilize Bob Hall Field to access the Chagrin River as part of a training for stream habitat assessment. The class will be held on October 5-6, 2016 and will train staff from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources Scenic Rivers Program. The class is a two day event that includes classroom training and field assessment training at several stream sites. In looking at the access and parking facilities at Bob Hall Field, it appears to be an ideal location to use for one of the field training sites.

The majority of the class will be held at the West Woods Park. Our use of the river at Bob Hall Field would be limited to 2 to 3 hours, and simply involves wading in the stream to record habitat features that are present using a procedure developed by the State of Ohio. The off street parking and easy access to the river at Bob Hall Field make this site ideal for these purposes. I will be leading the class as a volunteer, and the training is being offered to the ODNR staff people free of charge.
