OTHER BUSINESS: The Commission discussed the progress of the Land Use Guide Plan. It was suggested that someone look into the possibility of a Cleveland State University or Kent State University student review the plan to ensure that it flows properly and do any necessary editing. Mr. Warren asked that all changes be submitted to him by December $14^{\rm th}$.

Mr. Warren stated a resident contacted him with concern that there may be a conflict with Amendment 2016-7 to amend the Zoning Resolution Section 4.6 Permitted Modifications and Exceptions, Section 5.2 Residential Zones and Section 7.5 Nonconforming Lots of Record, and the impervious surface section of the Zoning Resolution. The Geauga County Prosecutors Office is reviewing this matter.

The Zoning Secretary stated that the Board of Zoning Appeals has asked to hold off on their request to allow for alternates on their Board. They would like to review the 2017 meeting schedule and see if there are any attendance conflicts before the Zoning Commission amends the Zoning Resolution.

An amendment to address the new House Bill 523 was distributed and discussed. The amendment would add the term Medical Marijuana to the Zoning Code and add a section under prohibited uses for the cultivating, processing, or retail dispensing of medical marijuana. This was the recommendation of the Geauga County Planning Commission and was reviewed by the Geauga County Prosecutors Office.

At 8:20 p.m., Mr. Dickinson moved to enter into executive session pursuant Section 121.22(G) of the Ohio Revised Code to discuss personnel matters, seconded by Ms. Weiss Carson. In favor; Mr. Warren – yes, Ms. Weiss Carson – yes, Mr. Dickinson – yes. Motion passed.
