Mr. Dickinson asked the Zoning Inspector if there was a contact in the OTA. Mr. Dickinson would like to know what the latest take on a townships abilities with an architectural review board. Could this board help regulate commercial structures in the future? Mr. Dickinson also asked if there was a portal on the township website for residents to get to storm water information. Mr. Wrench said there is a link that will take you to the storm water webpage.

The board discussed storage containers, and if there could be a limit on how long they are permitted, and where they are permitted on the property. The board discussed storage containers and since they are placed on the ground if this makes them structures, or if they could have a temporary use?

The board discussed driveway width and that ODOT determines what is permitted.
